

## **D-SAACP Info Paper**

## **Program Overview:**

The DoD Sexual Assault Advocate Certification Program (D-SAACP) recognizes the critical support Sexual Assault Prevention and Response (SAPR) Program Managers (PMs), Sexual Assault Response Coordinators (SARCs), and Sexual Assault Prevention and Response (SAPR) Victim Advocates (VAs) provide to victims of sexual assault from initial report through case conclusion, or until the point the victim no longer requires assistance. SAPR PMs, SARCs, and SAPR VAs certified through D-SAACP will join a growing field of certified civilian victim advocates who are trained and committed to upholding the highest standards of victim care and privacy.

## **Upcoming Deadlines:**

NOVA and DoD SAPRO have collaborated to identify ways to incorporate more review boards for faster credentialing of the field. Since July 2023, the D-SAACP Review Committee has added the first round of additional review periods, moving to eight (8) boards a year in 2024. The eight (8) boards a year will continue. Please note that moving forward the deadlines are fluid to ensure that the reviews are happening approximately every six (6) weeks. The website will be updated to provide details for future boards.
